DESCRIPTION OR LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of FIRST ADDITION TO OAK SHADE PARK, A PART OF LOTS 2 & 3, GOVT. SURVEY, RR. SEC. 2, CAMBRIDGE TWP., LENAWEE CO., MICH. is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the west line of lot 2, Govt. Survey, R.R. Sec. 2, Town & South, Range E. and, with the north line of Beach Drive, at the plot of Oak Shade Park, said point being one-half mile from the southwest corner of said lot 2, and running thence northeasterly to the south shore of Wampers Lake, thence northeasterly, one-half mile, thence N. 70° E., 100.0 ft. to the northwest corner of lot 1, one end of the plot of Oak Shade Park, thence S. 50° E., 200.0 ft. to the north line of Beach Drive, at said plot, thence S. 50° E., 200.0 ft. to the plan of beginning.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plot herein delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments of not less than one inch in diameter and fifteen inches in length, set in a concrete base of least four inches in diameter and forty-eight inches in depth, have been placed at points marked thus [square] as shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land plotted, at all intersections of streets and alleys and at the intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plot as shown on said plat.
